
DEUTERONOMY 6 TEFILLIN

- Rambam = Maimonides
- The purpose of *Tefillin*, tsitsit, and a mezuzah are to keep the Lord and His commands in constant reminder
- > Angel = *malach*
- Malach = messenger



Shema

(Deuteronomy 6:4 with a traditional melody)




The translation may or may not be recited:

Hear O Israel, Adonai is your God, Adonai is one.

"These Words are to be on your heart...."

- Shema is the central tenet of the Judeo-Christian faith
- "these words" refer to the Shema & ALL the laws and commands of God
- To "love the Lord your God" is the CONTEXT in which the Law is to be carried out

THE HEAD OF THE HOUSEHOLD AS THE TEACHER





- "when at home...when away....when you lie down....when you get up..."
- Merism = a poetic statement whereby a single thought is referred to by enumerating its main parts or outer boundaries
- This statement means "at all times..."

"Bind these commands as a sign on our hands.....forehead.."

- Judaism is undecided whether this is literal or a metaphor
- > Tefillin is Hebrew
- > Phylactery is Greek
- Leather boxes with straps
- Four passages of Scripture usually inside the boxes
- Worn during morning prayers BUT not normally on Shabbat






TEFILLIN IS A TRADITION

- Wearing Tefillin started no earlier than 250 B.C.
- Pharisees wore Tefillin all day long!
- Samarian Jews did NOT believe in wearing Tefillin
- No evidence of use of Tefillin in the Galilee area
- Tefillin found at Qumran, so Essenes wore it


DID JESUS WEAR TEFILLIN?

- Probably NOT!
- Common peasants (especially from Galilee) were NOT known to wear Tefillin
- ➤ IS WEARING TEFILLIN WRONG? NO!!!!
- But it is NOT a direct or clear Biblical command
- Rambam and many great Jewish sages agree that it is a metaphor
- Phylactery is a common Greek word for "amulet"
- Amulet is a magic charm



THE PROBLEM WITH SYMBOLS AND IMAGES

- Not every symbol of God or Heaven is prohibited
- Torah gives strict rules on the content and use of symbols
- Top on the list is NOT to make an image of Yehoveh as a HUMAN
- NO created things: stars, the moon, animals, fish
- Mezuzahs and tsitsit do NOT violate God's rules regarding symbols





THE MEZUZAH

- > A mezuzah is for remembering
- Placed on city gates or on one's home doorway
- Writing epithets on city entrances or doorways was typical Middle Eastern custom
- > ALL Jews in Jesus day did this
- Practice started in the 2nd Temple period (after return from Babylon)

SMALL SCROLL PLACED INSIDE OF MEZUZAH

- Scroll usually was of Deut.6:4-9 and 11:13-21
- Mezuzahs found at Qumran, so were used by Essenes
- Like Tefillin,
 Mezuzahs at times
 were given a
 "magical" quality

MEZUZAH PLACEMENT

- Right side (outside looking in)
- Upper 1/3rd
- Top angled inward
- If we're going to use them, it is a better witness to Jews to do it according to Traditions




DON'T FORGET THE LORD IN THE MIDST OF PROSPERITY!

- It is man's tendency to look at ourselves instead of God when we are prosperous
- The seeking for, and attainment of, wealth is what causes most people to go astray
- This is NOT glorifying poverty!
- Hebrews are told that what they are about to receive in the Promised Land THEY did not build, nor did they earn it
- What we build on our own efforts will burn; what the Lords builds will survive forever



NO PASSIVITY!

- We must fight the good battle
- The lives of all Israelites were put on the line even though the Lord had prepared the victory
- Characteristics of a God-led leader:
 - 1) Sacrificial
 - 2) Accountable
 - 3) Open to discipline
 - 4) Goals for the benefit of the group AND the Kingdom of God



DO NOT FOLLOW AFTER OTHER PEOPLE'S GODS!



Scripture defines IDOLATRY as anything placed ahead of God

God's people are not to seek and follow what the world naturally seeks and follows

We can NOT seek things of the world, add a religious element to it, and then pretend that this is not idolatry!

WHY IS THE CHURCH DECLINING?

- Since 1965 church attendance in America began to dwindle
- Growth and prosperity became the #1 goal
- Church moved towards the WORLD rather than maintaining high standards
- 200 years ago, Europe 90%Christian. Today, less than 3%
- In America, since 1990, church attendance dropping at 1% per year
- We have been chasing after other gods!!
